## **Adjectives** Comparative and Superlative

(when nouns are compared using the adjectives)

Example:	<u>adjective</u>	<u>comparative</u>	<u>superlative</u>
	big	bigger	biggest
	good	better	best

To change an adjective to: comparative, add *ah* superlative, add *sht* 

adjective	comparative	superlative
sees	sees <i>ah</i>	see <i>sht</i>
(sweet)	(sweeter)	(sweetest)
shloh	shloh <i>ah</i>	shloh <i>sht</i>
(slow)	(slower)	(slowest)
vayyich	vayyich <i>ah</i>	vayyich <i>sht</i>
(soft)	(softer)	(softest)

## Example:

Da Aaron sei abbel is **sees**, 's Reanna sei abbel is **sees***ah*, avvah da Alex sei abbel is da **see***sht*.

Da Levi sei koo is **shloh**, da William sei koo is **shloh**<u>a</u>*h*, avvah da John sei koo is di **shloh**<u>s</u>*ht*.

'S gayl kissi is **vayyich**, 's bloh kissi is **vayyich**<u>ah</u>, avvah 's roht kissi is 's **vayyich**<u>sht</u>.

## <u>Adjectives</u> <u>Comparative and Superlative</u>

The root word changes in the following adjectives:

adjective	comparative	superlative
ald (old)	eldah (older)	eldsht (oldest)
feel (much)	may (more)	mensht (most)
goot (good)	bessah (better)	besht (best)
grohs (big)	graysah	graysht
hohch (high)	haychah	haychsht
kald (cold)	keldah	keldsht
lang (long)	lengah	lengsht
nayksht (near or close)	naychah	naykshtisht
shay (nice)	shennah	shensht
shpoht (late)	shpaydah	shpohtsht
vennich (small amount)	vennichah (less)	vennichsht (least)
voahm (warm)	veahmah	voahmsht
yung (young)	yingah	yingsht
