## Subject Pronoun

I throw the ball.  
You like to study.  
He eats green beans.  
She likes cherry pie.  
It is a good cherry pie.  
We go to the meeting.  
They are happy.  
You all do good.

## Object Pronoun

John throws the ball to me.  
 John wants to talk with you.  
 Mary likes him.  
 John likes her.  
 John eats it.  
 John talks to us.  
 John helps them.  
 I try to teach you all.
